SUBJECT: DAMAGE TO UAMS PROPERTY

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to notify employees, students, faculty and staff within the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) of the procedures to be followed in the event of damage to UAMS property.

POLICY

Intentional damage to University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) property by employees, students, staff, and/or faculty must be fully reimbursed by the responsible party(ies).

SCOPE


This policy applies to all UAMS employees, students, faculty and staff.

PROCEDURE

- (1) Individuals responsible for intentional property damage will be liable for costs incurred in repair or replacement of such property.
- (2) The Vice Chancellor for Campus Operations will be responsible for evaluating all such incidents, determining the cost, and implementing the appropriate method of reimbursement.
- (3) Individuals responsible for property damage may be subject to disciplinary action up to or including immediate termination or, in the case of students, expulsion from school.

SANCTIONS

Violation of this Policy will result in disciplinary action in accordance with [Policy 4.4.02](#) and college policies.
