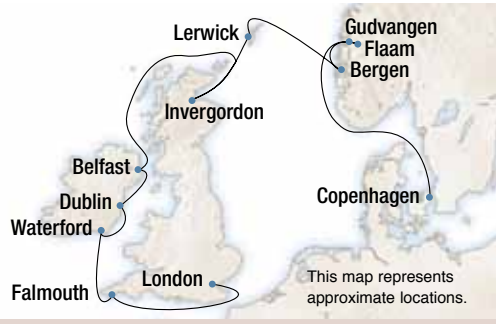

FLAAM (SOGNEFJORD), NORWAY

Surrounded by steep mountains, thundering waterfalls, and emerald-green valleys, tiny Flaam clings to the innermost point of Sognefjord, Europe's longest, deepest fjord. It's a fairy-tale setting that can be enjoyed many ways. Ride the Flaam Railway, one of the world's steepest, as it loops through the virgin wilderness, just as it has since the 1940s.

GUDVANGEN (SOGNEFJORD), NORWAY

Gudvangen is renowned for its spectacular natural beauty and is centrally located on the majestic Sognefjorden. For scenic views travel on the Flaam Railway, visit the Kjosfossen Waterfall and enjoy an abundance of photo opportunities to capture the splendor of the Norwegian countryside. Take a leisurely afternoon stroll along the waterfront or simply relax at the fabled Fjordtell resort.

BERGEN, NORWAY

Norway's medieval capital pays homage to its past with wooden houses and cobble streets that grace the historic Bryggen area around the wharf. Here, the Hanseatic Museum reveals a glimpse of working life in the Middle Ages, and the eerie, 13th-century Rosenkrantz Tower offers a phenomenal view of the seaport. The modern city tempts visitors with attractions such as the Akvariet city aquarium and Trolls' Hill, the romantic summer villa of Norwegian composer Edvard Grieg, who's buried on the estate.

LERWICK (SHETLAND ISLANDS), SCOTLAND

Drive through beautiful valleys and flower-filled meadows with romping Shetland ponies to quaint villages like Scalloway with its ruined castle. Or explore the fascinating Jarlshof prehistoric site, occupied for more than 3,000 years.

Northern Scotland, known as the Highlands, is one of the most scenic places in Europe, a landscape of mountains and forested hills. Venture into the Highlands where the local clan castles perch on craggy hills.
