Ports of Call

PORTOFINO, ITALY

Portofino and Santa Margherita define the word “picturesque.” Stunning scenery continues in the beautiful coastal resorts of Ravello, Sestri Levante and San Fruttuoso.

LA SPEZIA (CINQUE TERRE), ITALY

Discover the five stunning, colorful towns clinging to the cliffs along the coast. Take a boat tour to see them from the water as ancient seafarers did, and go ashore and explore one of the picturesque towns. Or visit intriguing Portovenere, another colorful town rising above one end of La Spezia’s harbor with breathtaking views and the lovely Church of San Pietro.

MONTE CARLO, MONACO

Take in sparkling Monaco as you drive along the famous Grand Corniche, then stroll through the old quarter. See the pink palace of the Grimaldi family, visit the Casino, explore the Côte d’Azur from Nice to Cannes, Grasse and the lovely St. Paul de Vence, each a jewel to savor.

FLORENCE/PISA (LIVORNO), ITALY

Explore the fabled architecture of Renaissance Florence: the Duomo with Brunelleschi’s dome, the Baptistery, Michelangelo’s *David*, the bridge over the Arno and the Uffizi Gallery. Visit Pisa’s superb Field of Miracles and the iconic Leaning Tower. Or lose yourself in the Tuscan countryside and the towns of Siena, and San Gimignano renowned for its medieval towers.

AMALFI/POSITANO, ITALY

Clinging to steep slopes above a sparkling bay, Positano charms all who visit with its Moorish-style houses and colorful fishing boats. Continue on to enchanting Amalfi, filled with ancient wonders like the 12th-century Capuchin monastery and the beautiful 11th-century Cathedral and cloister.

SORRENTO/CAPRI, ITALY

Immerse yourself in Capri, with its stunning panoramas, villages, charming piazzas and the Villa San Michele. Visit the ruins at Pompeii or take a cooking lesson in Sorrento.

TAORMINA (SICILY), ITALY

Enjoy panoramic views as you ascend to Taormina where you’ll stroll medieval lanes past historic palaces. See the famed Greek Theater and its fantastic view of Mt. Etna. Or venture up the volcano itself, where remnants of past eruptions can be seen in cones, craters and lava streams. Explore the countryside and its lovely hill towns, discover a Norman castle built of black lava, and visit beautiful old Catania.

CORFU, GREECE

Discover glorious beaches, serene monasteries, beautiful palaces, traditional mountain towns and Corfu’s lovely old Venetian quarter. Or learn to prepare traditional Greek dishes at a local restaurant and feast on the results.

KOTOR, MONTENEGRO

The twisting, pink-paved streets and distinctive architecture in this beautiful medieval city reflect its Byzantine and Venetian influences. Stroll through town and tour the imposing St. Tryphon Cathedral consecrated in 1166.

DUBROVNIK, CROATIA

This walled medieval city is known for its exquisite Venetian monuments. See the Franciscan monastery, the Rector’s Palace and the Cathedral. Or explore the countryside with a visit to Cavtat, an enchanting seaside resort that began life as a Greek colony. Visit a local family and enjoy a traditional welcome of brandy and figs, serenaded by local musicians.

VENICE, ITALY

Glide through the canals, under bridges, past opulent palazzi and elegant churches. Take in Venice’s secret quarters, the Doge’s Palace and St. Mark’s Basilica, Burano and the glass factories on Murano. Or enjoy the scenic countryside with its stunning Palladian villas.
