CCTR Research Accelerator is for all members of our community, including faculty, students, post docs, research scientists, lab technicians, and others involved with scientific research.

The centerpiece of CCTR Research Accelerator is a customized database that enables researchers to quickly list any kind of resource (data, reagents, cell lines, antibodies, human samples, research projects, transgenic animals, etc.). With just a few clicks, other researchers at UAMS, and if you choose, at Yale, UCSD, The Salk Institute, and Cambridge, will be able to browse, search, access this information, and collaborate.

You can invite discussions about a listing, create peer groups, and receive alerts to be notified when another colleague lists a relevant resource.

Postings can contain as much—or as little—descriptive information as you wish. Collaborations develop on your own schedule, at your choosing, with a level of disclosure that fits your needs and comfort level.
