**UAMS Dental Hygiene Student Table Clinics (2 CEUs)**

UAMS Senior dental hygiene students will present educational table clinics on a variety of dental topics. **Date:** Friday, February 19; **Time:** Noon to 2:00pm; **Place:** Concourse area of the Education II Building – G-level; **Cost:** \$20.00

**Administration & Monitoring of Nitrous Oxide for Dental Assistants and Hygienists (5 CEUs)**

This course will address the utilization of nitrous oxide/oxygen therapy for psychoseparation as well as provide a review of the respiratory and cardiovascular systems and preoperative and postoperative medications. A laboratory (clinic) session is included. This course complies with the Rules and Regulations of the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners, 2010, for the administration & monitoring of nitrous oxide. **Date:** Friday, March 12; **Time:** 8 am – 2 pm; **Place:** UAMS Campus **Cost:** \$150.00

**Local Anesthesia for Dental Hygienists (32 CEUs)**

This comprehensive course covers the basic concepts of local anesthesia including anatomy, pharmacology, medical history review and emergency management. The laboratory emphasizes the practice of safe techniques for effective administration. This course complies with the Rules and Regulations of the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners, 2010, for the application for a dental hygiene local anesthesia permit. **Date:** June 1 through 4 (must attend all 4 days); 8:00 am - 4:30 pm; **Cost:** \$1,025.00 (includes study guides and lab materials); Please register before May 14<sup>th</sup> as space is limited. **Required Textbook:** *Handbook of Local Anesthesia* by Stanley Malamed, 5<sup>th</sup> edition, Mosby, 2004, ISBN: 0323024491. The textbook may be purchased prior to the course at the UAMS Bookstore or any textbook seller (Amazon, etc.).

**Supplemental Techniques in Local Anesthesia for Dentists and Dental Hygienists (6 CEUs)** –A review of basic injection techniques as well as instruction on additional techniques such as pediatric injection techniques, PDL and intraseptal injections, infiltrations, Oraquix, and the CompuDent dental anesthesia wand. Differing types of syringes available for injections will be discussed. This course includes a hands-on clinical practice session and is intended for hygienists who currently hold a local anesthesia permit. **Date:** Friday, June 11; **Time:** 8:30 am to 3:00 pm; **Place:** UAMS Campus – room to be announced; **Cost:** \$195 includes all course materials and lunch. Participants will have the opportunity to purchase a Septodont Perojet PDL syringe for \$120 (retails for \$239). A minimum of 8 participants is needed to hold the course. So please pre-register by May 28th.
