

# **ANATOMY & PHYSIOLOGY FOR REGISTRARS** **Continuing Education Course**

## **A basic course of anatomy: structures and function**

This basic course offers an introduction to the body structures as well as the function of each through the use of a coloring workbook. This method of learning aids the student in the experience of learning anatomy through illustration. Color coding schemes are encouraged to help the student identify various structures. This text also provides content for the student to learn as well as giving class assignments and homework.

The class will meet weekly for 2 hours for twelve (12) weeks. Content will be taught through classroom exercises and practice using a workbook as well as materials prepared by the instructor. Weekly testing and homework will be given to assess the student's progress and ultimately competency of anatomy and physiology of the body.

The cost is \$250.00 per person. This includes textbook, drawing pens, and all materials.

This seminar is a pre-requisite to the registry track program. Class and will be taught in 12 sessions and will form in the Spring and Fall. Location: UAMS campus, Shorey Bldg., Eighth Floor, Room 16.

Classes are offered locally and with distance methodologies. The online methodologies will be available so that students outside Little Rock may be served. Students must have Internet access with email and PowerPoint presentation software in order to take these courses.
