

**PATHOPHYSIOLOGY WITH PHARMACOLOGY FOR REGISTRARS**  
**Continuing Education Course**

**A basic course of human diseases and common drugs for each**

This basic course offers an introduction to the most commonly seen diseases of the body as well as the common drug for each. This overview course includes the etiology, symptoms, treatment, and prognosis for the major diseases of the body. Common drugs and prescriptions are covered for the diseases reviewed. The text provides the basic content for the student to learn and the instructor uses the web so that students are trained in the most up-to-date prescriptions and therapies in healthcare today.

The class will meet weekly for 3 hours for eleven (11) weeks. Content will be taught through classroom exercises and practice using a workbook as well as materials prepared by the instructor. Class assignments, exercises, and homework will be given to assess the student's progress and the student's competency is assessed by four exams given throughout this course.

The cost is \$250.00 per person. This includes textbook and all materials.

This seminar is a pre-requisite to the registry track program. Class and will be taught in 10 sessions and will form in the Spring and Fall. Location: UAMS campus, Shorey Bldg., Eighth Floor, Room 16.

Classes are offered locally and with distance methodologies. The online methodologies will be available so that students outside Little Rock may be served. Students must have Internet access with email and PowerPoint presentation software in order to take these courses.
