

MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY FOR REGISTRARS

Continuing Education Course

A basic course of medical terms, abbreviations, singular/plurals, with an emphasis on cancer and registry terminology

This basic course offers an introduction to the language of medicine with emphasis placed on terminology of all anatomical body systems, roots or words, prefixes and suffixes. The study also includes medical abbreviations, singular and plural medical terms, and a major emphasis on terminology found in oncology and in cancer registries.

The class will meet for 10 weeks for 2 hours. Content will be taught through classroom exercises and practice using a workbook (instructor was contributing author) as well as materials prepared by the instructor. Testing and homework will be given to assess the student's progress and ultimately competency of medical terms.

The cost is \$150.00 per person. This includes textbook and all materials.

This seminar is a pre-requisite to the registry track program. Class and will be taught in 10 sessions and will form in the Spring and Fall. Location: UAMS campus, Shorey Bldg., Eighth Floor, Room 16.

Classes are offered locally and with distance methodologies. The online methodologies will be available so that students outside Little Rock may be served. Students must have Internet access with email and PowerPoint presentation software in order to take these courses.
