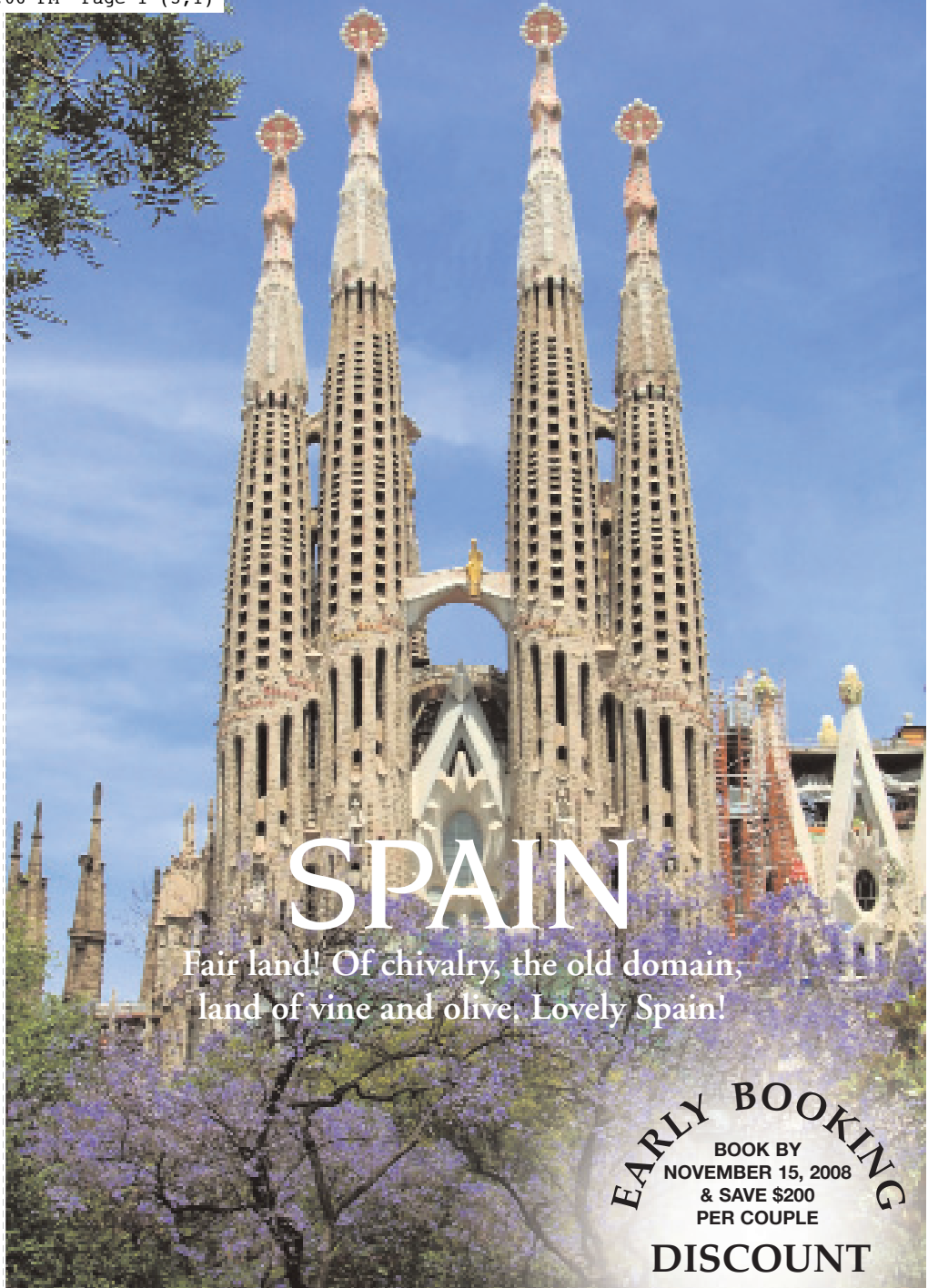

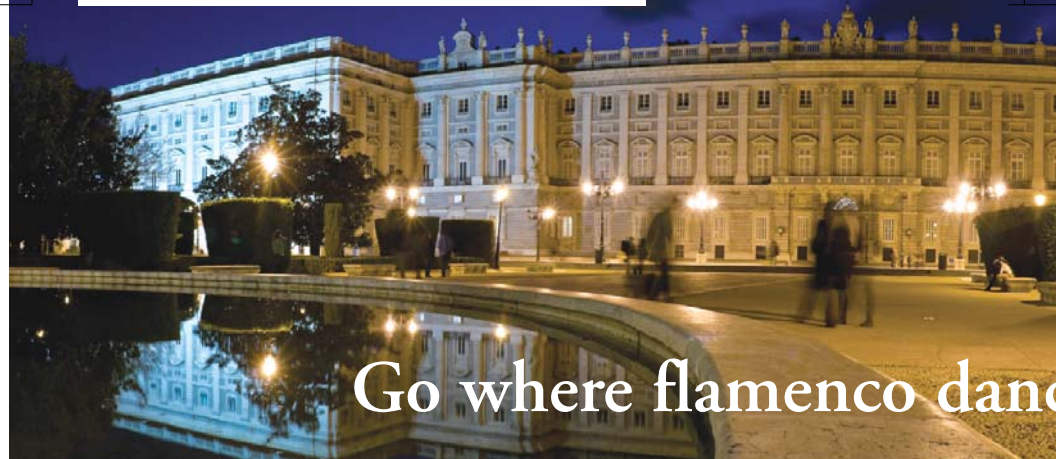

## *A Man and His Masterpiece*

No person has left their mark upon the face of Barcelona like that of Spain's beloved architect, Antoni Gaudí. Born in Catalonia, Gaudí spent his adult life working in Barcelona, leaving behind a trail of work, of which seven have been declared World Heritage Sites. His unusual, fairy-tale like buildings and whimsical parks can be found creating a colorful patchwork across the face of the city. Gaudí's undisputed masterpiece is the fantastical Sagrada Familia (Church of the Holy Family). He began the project in 1882, but with no deadline, the church was still incomplete at the time of his death in 1926. Legend has it that not one straight line or right angle exists within the church's unusual structure, producing a bizarre melting effect. The exterior is exhaustively embedded with allegorical sculptures and its jagged spires distinctively pierce the skyline. Even in its unfinished state, the Sagrada Familia is a stunning feat of engineering and imagination, as well as a proud symbol of Barcelona.

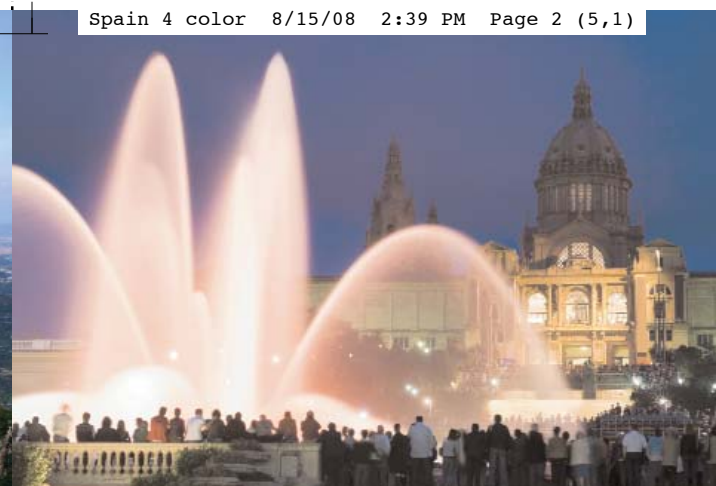
