**2009**

- January 12, 2009      7:00 p.m. (COPH G219 – Pauly Auditorium) - Junior class meeting to informally discuss issues related to the senior year. The Residency Selection Handbook will be distributed.
- January 13, 2009      (approximately) - A memo will be mailed to juniors re: 1) Senior Advisory System and a list of potential advisors, 2) Announce required February Class Meeting.
- February 6, 2009      4:00 p.m. - Senior Advisor request forms should be in the Student Affairs office by this date.
- February 12, 2009      (approximately) - The Student Affairs office will complete the list of senior advisor/students, and mail transcripts and junior clerkship evaluations to the senior advisors. The Electives catalog will be distributed.
- February 23, 2009      7:00 p.m. – **(COPH G219 – Pauly Auditorium) - Required Junior Class Meeting.** 1) Formal explanation of the senior year, 2) Begin senior elective scheduling process, 3) Elect Senior Class officers if the class wishes to do so. Senior Pictures (cap and gown) will be made between 4:30 and 7:00 p.m. (If you want to have your senior picture made before this, just call media services and make an appointment. Be sure you tell them that it is for your senior picture).
- March 26, 2009      4:00 p.m. - Deadline for submission of Primary Care Selective/Specialties/AI Request Form to the Student Affairs office.
- March 28 - April 5, 2009 - Junior Spring Break.
- April 6, 2009      Final Primary Care Selective/Specialties/AI schedules should be available in the Student Affairs Office. If you failed to get one of the required courses in the computer run, you will be placed into one that is still open at random. If a student receives a Primary Care Selective, Specialty clerkship, or an AI that is simply not acceptable, the student may drop the rotation(s) using a special form available in the Dean's office. On May 12, 2009, students may begin adding this (these) back using a Drop/Add form, selecting from whatever is still open at that time. Remember that you must do one of each of these rotations as a requirement for graduation, so if you drop one, you will have to add one back, even if you can't get one that is highly desirable to you because it is already filled
- April 23, 2009      4:00 p.m. - Deadline for submission of the Electives Request Form.

May 4, 2009	Pick up the final schedule from the Student Affairs office. No changes in this schedule will be accepted until May 12, 2009.
May 12, 2009	Students can begin using Drop/Add forms for schedule changes.
June 26, 2009	Last day of classes for current juniors.
July 6, 2009	8:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. - Formal Senior Registration (Those seniors who will be out of town on this date will need to speak with Ms. Dwana McKay, Registrar, to arrange an alternate date for registration). Registration will be held on the 9 <sup>th</sup> floor of the EdII building.
July 7, 2009	Senior year begins - <b><u>All student MUST have 36 hours on their schedules by this date.</u></b>
December 19, 2009	Winter Break begins.
