From I-630 take exit 3B turning north on to Cedar/Pine, take Pine street north to Markham, at traffic light turn west on to Markham at second traffic light turn south on to Hooper Drive. Parking is free on the weekends in the employee parking lot that is on the left and runs parallel with Markham. Take Hooper Drive traffic circle back towards Markham and the entrance to the employee parking lot is on your right. The CPH (ED III) building is the 1st building on Hooper Drive.
