NIH PUBLIC ACCESS POLICY

Norka Ruiz Bravo, PhD, NIH Deputy Director for Extramural Research, sent an email to the members of the NIH Research Community on April 28, 2008 with a reminder concerning the NIH Public Access Policy <http://grants.nih.gov/grants/guide/notice-files/NOT-OD-08-033.html>.

This policy applies to final peer-reviewed manuscripts accepted for publication on or after April 7, 2008. It states that making published research funded by NIH accessible to everyone, including health care providers, patients, educators and scientists, helps advance science and improves human health.

The NIH Public Access Policy implements Division G, Title II, Section 218 of PL 110-161, which was signed into law late last year.

COMPLIANCE TIPS

Do you need to make a change in study data recorded on paper? If so, use the accepted standard method for making changes – draw a single line through the incorrect information, write in the correct information, and then initial, date, and document the reason for the change. Don't use correction fluid to obliterate the original data, and don't scribble out so thoroughly that it's no longer legible. Everything in research must be documented – including data changes or corrections.
