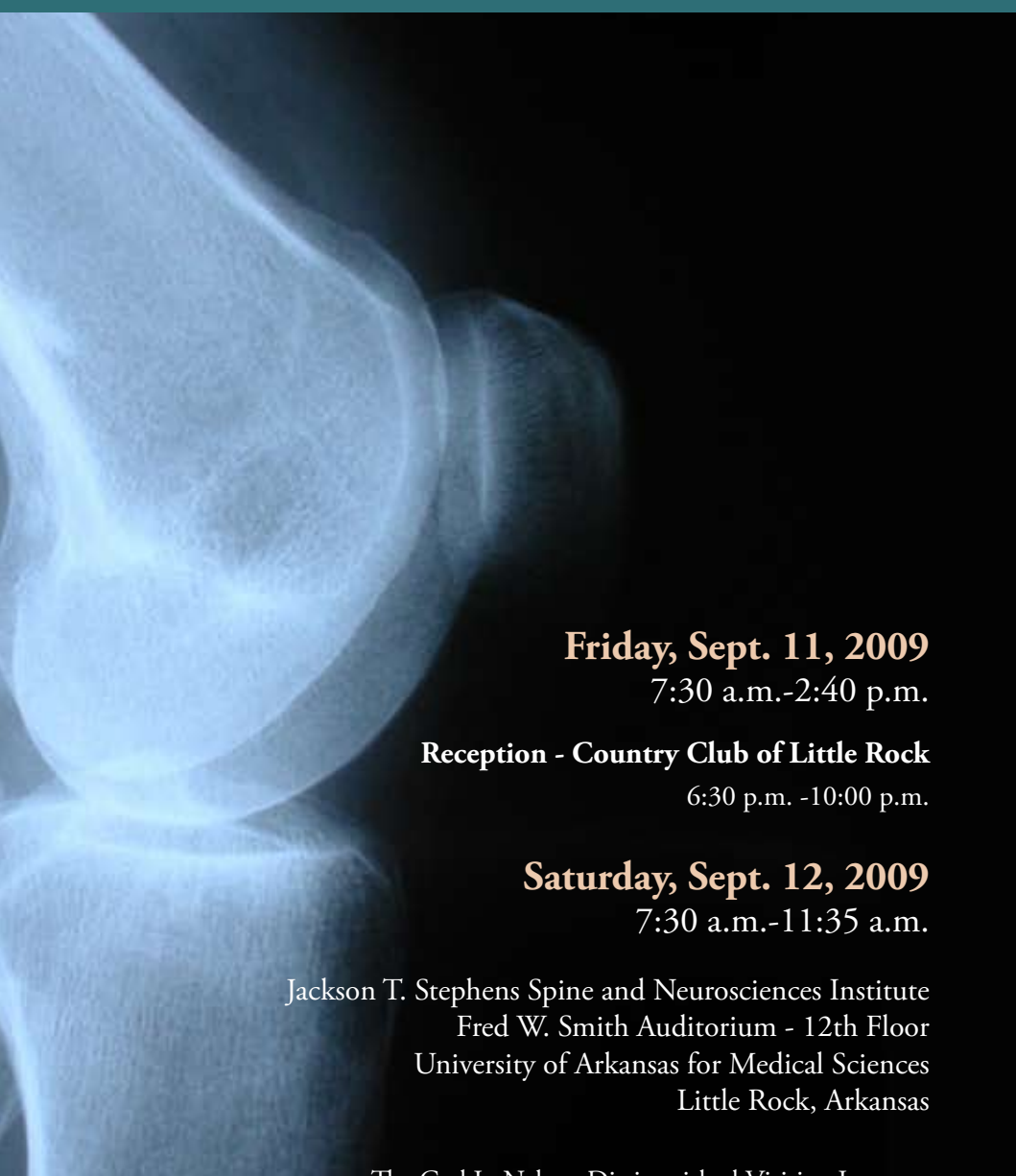

Target Audience

This seminar is designed for orthopaedic and trauma surgeons, residents, nurses, medical students, researchers and anyone interested in surgery of the knee and shoulder, the Arkansas Trauma System and healthcare reform.

Course Objectives

Following this activity, the participant should be able to:

- Introduce the concept and scientific rationale of kinematic/mechanical alignment of total knee arthroplasty.
- Demonstrate the surgical technique of kinematic/mechanical alignment with use of image-generated custom-fit cutting guides to place the femoral and tibial components accurately in all six-degrees-of-freedom.
- Discuss clinical results of kinematic/mechanical alignment.
- Following the presentation, the participant should understand the differences, advantages and disadvantages between kinematic/mechanical alignment and conventional and computer-assisted alignment of total knee arthroplasty.
- The participant will have a thorough introduction in the methodology and use of image-generated custom-fit cutting guides to improve intraoperative accuracy of placing the femoral and tibial components.

Location

The seminar will be held in the Fred W. Smith Auditorium in the Jackson T. Stephens Spine and Neurosciences Institute on the UAMS campus. The Stephens Spine and Neurosciences Institute is located at the corner of Sixth Street and Jack Stephens Drive (formerly Elm Street).
