### Dr. Christopher D.M. Fletcher, M.D.

Dr. Christopher D.M. Fletcher is an internationally renowned expert in soft tissue pathology. He received his medical degrees from St. Thomas' Hospital Medical School (MBBS) and the University of London (MD), and served as a Consultant Histopathologist and the Director of the Soft Tissue Tumor Unit at St. Thomas' Hospital in London for six years. In 1995, Dr. Fletcher became the Director of Surgical Pathology at the Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School. He serves on the editorial board of almost all major surgical pathology journals and is the editor of a major textbook dedicated solely to tumor pathology. He has lectured world-wide and has published approximately 450 original articles related to soft tissue pathology. Dr. Fletcher is well known not only for his diagnostic acumen, but also for his highly effective and entertaining teaching style.

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This year's course will feature an update on two aspects of soft tissue pathology by Dr. Christopher Fletcher: dermal based fibrous and fibrohistiocytic tumors and a review of vascular tumors. These will be followed by practical updates in hematopathology, ophthalmic pathology, bladder biopsy interpretation, thyroid cytology, and hepatic pathology. In addition, there will be three optional microscopic slide tutorials on Sunday morning in the areas of dermatopathology, gastrointestinal pathology, and urinary bladder pathology for an additional charge. Attendance at these tutorials will be limited in order to foster an informal atmosphere and allow interaction of participants with the faculty. A course syllabus will be provided. Commercial exhibitors will also be present.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This intensive one and one-half day review is designed for practicing pathologists, pathology residents, and other interested physicians who have the desire to remain abreast of current issues in surgical pathology.
