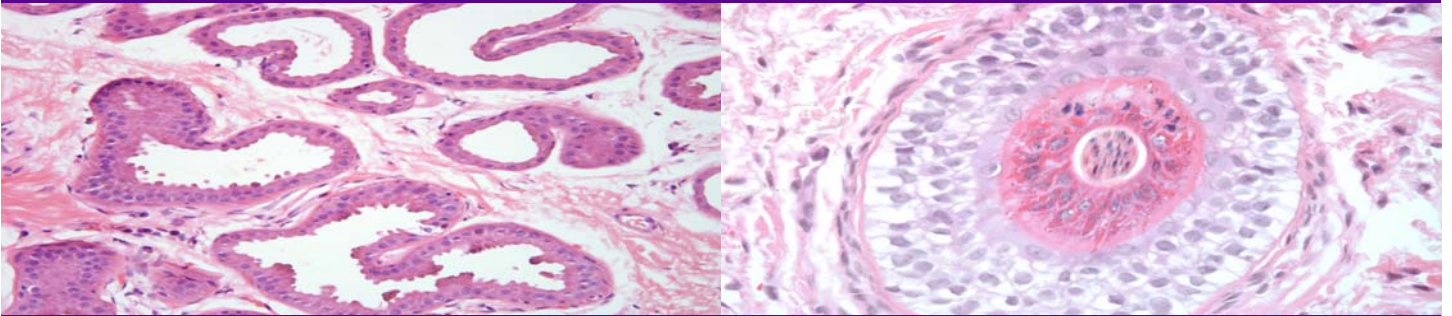

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will include updates on skin neoplasms including squamous cell carcinoma, eccrine carcinoma, merkel cell carcinoma, metastatic carcinoma and spindle cell tumors. At the end of this conference, the participant will be able to:

- Identify the criteria for diagnosing squamous cell carcinoma and the essential features to include in the pathology report
- Identify the current classification of eccrine carcinoma
- Identify the diagnostic criteria for merkel cell carcinoma
- Identify the diagnostic criteria for spindle cell tumors

FEATURED SPEAKERS

Dr. Bruce Smoller, Hough Endowed Professor and Chair of Pathology, Professor of Dermatology is an ex President of the American Society of Dermatopathology and past Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Cutaneous Pathology. His publications number over 300 including his most recent book, co-authored with Dr. Hiatt, “Basics in Dermatopathology”. His main interests lie in immunopathology and the study of cutaneous lymphoma.

Dr. Kim Hiatt, Associate Professor of Pathology and Dermatology and Director of Dermatopathology, is the Vice President of the Arkansas Foundation for Skin Cancer and the Co-Director of a prestigious short course at the USCAP entitled, “Deadly Dermatopathologic Disorders”. She is currently vigorously pursuing a line of research dedicated to discovering the precise etiology for nephrogenic systemic fibrosis.

Dr. Wang (Steve) Cheung, Assistant Professor of Pathology, arrived at UAMS in July 2009 upon completion of a dermatopathology fellowship with Dr. Hideko Kamino at NYU. Prior to that, Dr. Cheung did a residency in pathology at Johns Hopkins University and completed both an MD and PhD at the University of Virginia School of Medicine following his graduation from Harvard University. Steve has many publications and is continuing to use his strong research background as part of our program.

This intensive one day review is designed for practicing pathologists and dermatologists, residents in both disciplines, and other physicians who have the desire to remain abreast of current issues in dermatopathology.

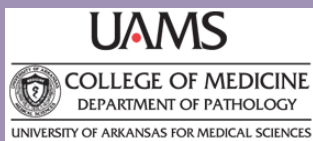
