UAMS MCAT Prep Course Student Housing Program

Student Housing Program: The program pays for overnight accommodations for every night before the UAMS MCAT Prep Course meets. This will typically mean Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday night. However, for the week following Memorial Day Weekend it will include only Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday night since class is not schedule to meet that Monday. The housing program is limited to students who live at least 50 miles or more from campus.

Eligibility: Acceptance into the UAMS MCAT Prep Program and living at least 50 miles or more from the UAMS campus. This program is for students who truly need to stay in Little Rock overnight due to the distance between their home and UAMS. Please submit this application only if you are committed to using the housing and are willing to accept the **penalties** for breaking this contract.

Rules & Regulations: The application form is a contract between the student and UAMS. By submitting the application the student is agreeing to use the provided housing **every** night before a scheduled class.

If the student requests housing, the MCAT Program will pay for housing prior to the beginning of class. If a student should fail to use the housing that has been secured for them, the student will be financially responsible for paying the UAMS MCAT Program for the nights they did not stay in their reserved housing unit. If the student is unable to stay in their pre-arranged housing then they must contact the MCAT Director's assistant, Lisa Bilello [Lbilello@uams.edu or (501) 686-5128], as soon as possible. In special circumstances, such as an emergency situation, the fee can be waived.

Complimentary housing is a benefit of the UAMS MCAT Program wants for students who truly need it and are willing to make a strong commitment to it.
